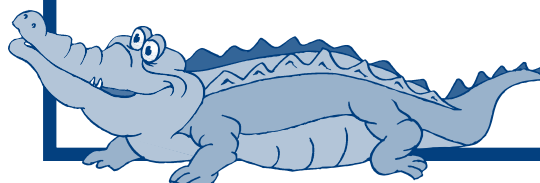
### Ultimate Exotic Animal Encounter

## **What's It All About?**

### **MONARCH BOOK AWARD**

In 2003, the Illinois School Library Media Association created the Monarch Children's Choice Book Award for Illinois students in grades K-3. The 2011 list of nominees includes twenty titles, and any student who has read or listened to at least five of the books may participate by voting for their favorite next February!

### **BLUESTEM BOOK AWARD**

Named in honor of the state prairie grass, Big Bluestem, this new Children's Choice award is designed for Illinois students in grades 3-5. The Bluestem list includes twenty nominated titles, and 2011 will be the first year for voting! Any student who has read or listened to at least four of the books may participate by voting for their favorite next year.
