Draw your favorite view from the road, landmark, road sign, billboard, scenic view, or any other creative design you can imagine that fits the *Road Trip* theme.

Tips for creating designs that will work

Make them tall or wide on an 8 ½" x 11" piece of paper.

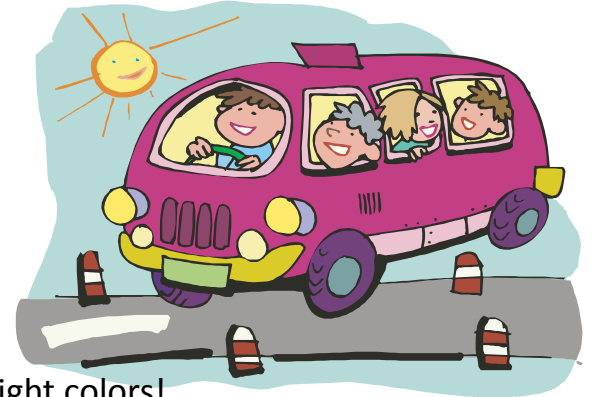
Fill in the background with color.

(Trees, sky, leaves, grass, buildings ... you get the idea!)

Use bright and vivid colors. Markers show up very well!

You can also be creative with a cut paper design, just use bright colors!

(Crayons and colored pencils do NOT show up well when we scan the design into the computer.)



Additional Information

Very Important: Put your name and phone number in pencil on the **back** of your design! Submit your entry in Youth Services anytime in **April 2010**. You can submit more than one design. Put your name and phone on the back of every entry.

You can design your mouse pad at home and bring it to Youth Services, or you may use supplies we provide at the library to create your entry.



Winning designs will be announced during **Children's Book Week, May 10-16, 2010**.

We will feature the artwork on new mouse pads in Youth Services.

We will not be able to use every drawing. Drawings chosen may be cropped to fit the mouse pad space.

If you want your design back, you must pick it up in Youth Services between **Monday, May 17** and **Sunday, June 6, 2010**.
